In Ireland, all new buildings which started construction since 1st November 2019 are required to meet the NZEB standards as set down in Part L and Part F of the Building Regulations.

This is also a key measure in Ireland's Climate Action Plan and is identified in Action 50 of the plan to up-skill current contractors / other industry players in deep retrofit, NZEB and new technology installations.

WWETB, in partnership with key stakeholders, have developed a suite of Nearly Zero Energy Building Construction Skills courses to offer to those in the Construction Sector.

The purpose of this information booklet is to give you all the information you may need before the course starts and as it progresses. We want to assure you of our commitment to delivering quality NZEB training.

CERTIFICATION

All NZEB courses are City & Guilds Assured and participants receive a digital badge and certificate upon completion.

To achieve the Digital Badge/Certificate, full attendance is required and the participant must also complete all activities and exercises as part of the course. For ventilation the participant must also successfully complete the theory and practical assessments.

HOW MUCH DOES EACH COURSE COST?

The course cost is €100 per day, i.e. a 1 day course is €100 and a 3 day course is €300.

You may be eligible for funding under the Skills to Advance Initiative (STA). STA is a SOLAS Initiative in partnership with WWETB and supported by Government. To check if you are eligible for funding please contact nzeb@wwetb.ie or 051 301500. Only those with an Irish PPS Number are eligible to apply for funding.

To avail of this funding participant's will be asked to complete a Learner Registration Form and a Skills to Advance Eligibility Form as part of the registration process.

If a participant would prefer not to complete these forms, the fee can be paid in full on the day and all we will require is the participant's name and PPS number to process their certification.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We will offer a full refund if you cancel your place at least 72 hours before the start date. If you qualify for funding and you do not cancel your booking at least 72 hours before the start date, you will not be eligible for funding if you choose to rebook a place at a later date.

HEALTH AND SAFETY



SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in the designated area outside. Vaping is not permitted inside the NZEB training venue.



PHONES

Phones must be switched off or on silent mode. If a participant needs to take an urgent call they will be required to leave the training venue so as not to disturb others.

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT

Any tools, equipment provided as part of the training are owned by WWETB. It is necessary to ensure that they are not abused or misused in any way.

Participants may be held financially accountable for any deliberate damage caused to WWETB equipment.

In the interest of safety, any breakage or damage to such items must be promptly reported to the tutor.

Participants are requested to tidy up after themselves and leave the area as they would like to find it. Please remove all rubbish, cups etc. from your desk and dispose of in the bins provided.



PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

Participants may be required to wear protective clothing as advised by their tutor. Protective clothing includes gloves and shoes.
